PLAYER AND PARENT COMMITMENT

All players and parents of players trying out for a travel soccer team should understand that accepting a place on a travel soccer team is a significant commitment. Players are expected to attend one to two practices per week, attend travel games (this means parents must arrange transport to practices and attend games), participate in at least one indoor session and play in selected tournaments. The number of positions available on each team will be determined after tryouts are completed. As you might expect, not every tryout participant will be offered a position on a travel team and some players may not be selected for the team of their first choice. Those players who are not offered a position will be placed on a waiting list and are encouraged to participate in the Recreational Soccer Program in the Fall and to attend one of the many programs designed for soccer skills development. *Initial team registration will take place in late summer. Players will continue to be evaluated through the fall and indoor seasons and, based on performance and commitment level, may or may not be asked to play on the team in the spring travel season. Final spring rosters will be set by January 2010 and are subject to change until the first game of the spring 2010 season or the South Shore Soccer League deadline, whichever comes first.* Being offered a position on a travel team now does not guarantee spring play. Players participating in the Travel program will be required to provide a copy of their birth certificate, a recent passport sized color photograph, a completed and signed MYSA registration form and a check made out to the Sharon Soccer Association for \$160 at the time of registration.
